About Coupa

What/who is Coupa?

Coupa, Inc. is the leading provider of cloud based procure-to-pay solutions. Coupa enables businesses to maximize spend under management, streamline order and invoicing processes and provide visibility and control for compliance. Coupa is a free, and flexible, web-based service. WestRock has chosen to use the Coupa Network (CSP) to streamline the procurement to payment process and utilize Coupa to electronically transmit purchase orders to, and receive invoices from, our suppliers.

How does my business benefit from e-commerce?

Using the Coupa Supplier Network (CSP) to send electronic invoices and receive electronic PO's eliminates the costs associated with handling, printing, stationary, and postage of these documents. Use of the Coupa greatly reduces the time it takes to send PO's to our suppliers and to receive invoices from them. It also reduces the expense of following up on missing/lost invoices, gives suppliers increased visibility of the invoice transmission process and increases the consistency of on-time payments and order placement. Highlights of some other benefits include:

- Online visibility to Purchase Orders, Payment Updates and Invoicing data

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What are the fees associated with this service?

The CSP is free of charge to suppliers doing business with WestRock. If you were previously budgeting for electronic transactions with WestRock, those transactions cost will go away when we move to Coupa.

What if I do not currently receive PO's from WestRock locations

The use of purchase orders ensures our suppliers are paid on time and accurately. If your business is not receiving purchase orders from WestRock, there may be a valid reason why, however most purchases are and should be PO based. What if I do not want to submit my invoices via CSP?

Use of the CSP benefits both WestRock and our suppliers, as it allows WestRock to streamline the Accounts Payable process, and improves our ability to pay invoices in a timely manner. E-invoicing adoption will be taken into consideration by WestRock when contract renewal takes place with your company and/or when other sourcing events arise. We would also like to highlight to you that WestRock is eliminating paper invoice and PO processing and this will be WestRock's combined Finance & Procurement policy. What is your primary purchasing system?

The primary ERP's affected are JDE and SAP. Orders can/will initiate directly from our ERP or from a Coupa catalog. No matter where the order initiates, the order will transmit via the Coupa Supplier Portal (CSP) to your registered account.

What if I am already a Coupa supplier?

If you are already a Coupa enabled supplier, please complete the Supplier Registration Form and we will send you an invite to join WestRock.

How am I selected for cXML vs CSP?

cXML vs CSP is a supplier decision. However, cXML customers tend to be high volume transactions, with more formal IT resources available for setup, configuration, testing and maintenance. CSP suppliers work well for small to medium sized businesses with decentralized processes and fewer monthly transactions.

Why is EDI not an option? I use EDI with my other customers?

Coupa currently supports cXML with no cost. EDI transactions require a third party and may incur costs for both WestRock and our suppliers.

Resources Requirements and Training

What resources are required for me to come onboard?

The <u>minimum</u> resource needed to receive electronic PO's and send e-invoices is access to the internet and an email address.

Do I need to install any software?

No, you do not need to install any software to use Coupa for PO/invoicing.

How will I be trained? What support is available?

Coupa invoicing is extremely easy to use and can be as simple as adding your invoice number to the PO located in your Coupa account. There are extensive online help documents, webinars and a call-in helpdesk available.
